Introduction

Welcome to the Spring 2023 edition of the AS Foundation's 'Making a Difference' report. In this edition, we will be measuring the impact of our grants by exploring the number of grants given and the types of difficulties faced by our beneficiaries. Importantly, we will also be highlighting the direct impact of the work we do on our beneficiaries in our personal testimonial pages. We also have highlights on our partnership with 'WeWork' last winter and the fundraising event hosted by Akin in April.

We believe that everyone, no matter their background, should have the means and access to enter the legal profession. According to the Solicitors Regulations Authority (SRA) in 2021, the national percentage of people from a lower socio-economic background is 37% when looking at the percentage of solicitors from lower socio-economic backgrounds, this is only 17%. This is far too low to be considered representative.

The AS Foundation are proud to continue to support individuals from lower socioeconomic backgrounds access the legal profession. By providing financial assistance to support aspiring solicitors in their studies, we are dedicated to ensuring they are able reach their legal ambitions, thus improving social mobility within the field of law, making it more diverse and representative.

The AS Foundation is incredibly pleased to be able to continue to work with our founders, our ongoing supporters and our newer supporters. Thank you to all. We support those entering the legal world to access appropriate work experience and support with their studies, which not only helps them realise their long-held career ambitions, but also enhances the workforce of commercial law firms across the UK.

Our mission


We aim to remove financial barriers to entering the legal profession for aspiring solicitors. We do this by providing financial assistance to those who need it most.

We receive applications from across the UK and include wide variety of backgrounds and geographies.


This map shows the approximate locations of our beneficiaries so far this year.

WeWork X AS Foundation Partnership

Last winter, we partnered with WeWork to provide some of our beneficiaries with discount codes that would give them up to 6 bookings to be able to study in a WeWork space over the following 12 months. We knew that in the current cost-of-living crisis, having a warm safe place to study could be a challenge therefore we are delighted this timely partnership has allowed us to offer this to our grant recipients. When asked how they found the opportunity, they responded with the following...

"I have found (WeWork) to be very useful. I enjoy going to the WeWork space because my house is quite noisy and I live opposite a school so it's never really quiet and I often lose focus so having the opportunity to study elsewhere is useful....Also, the fact that I can book space is much better than going to the library because I am guaranteed a space to study...It helps me focus and get things done without disruptions. I am more comfortable going here than to my local library. - Tamia




Who we have supported

"Receiving a grant from the AS Foundation was not only helpful practically, but it was emotionally helpful. I have had a real struggle gaining funding in even studying for the LPC, as options seem limited for those who struggle financially. I felt as though I was never going to be able to follow my dream, so the helpfulness and support from the amazing staff at the AS Foundation really boosted my hopes for my future.

The grant itself has allowed me to feel confident in myself when attending interviews or completing role play assessments for the LPC, such as advising a 'client'.

(For the future) ...I am still unsure of the area of law I would like to qualify in. At the moment, I simply want to do well in my LPC LLM and be offered a training contract with a firm that values their employees and supports them with their training into qualification, and one-day partnership.

The people at AS Foundation have always been professional and kind. They could not have been more helpful and if you are struggling, there is no shame in getting help. I used to feel this way, but the people at ASF made me feel the opposite and made me feel like they truly wanted to help me in any way that they could.

Anthony

Anthony is currently studying at Northumbria University.



They received two grants from the AS Foundation one to purchase business professional clothing and more recently, a subscription to keep up to date with legal news.

"As a formerly homeless person, I feel acutely out of place in commercial law environments...the first day of my work experience at a commercial law firm, (my) jacket ripped at the seams... it undermined my confidence and reminded me that I didn't belong. The suit that (the AS Foundation) purchased for me totally removed that barrier...the suit also removed another mental barrier, as I felt empowered that an organisation believed in me....and my ability to secure a training contract at a commercial law firm. The grant gave me the confidence to attend commercial law firms free from the previous anxiety about my work wear.

The FT subscription allowed me to stay on top of the commercial news and set alerts on my phone. I was able to...stay abreast of developments in the commercial world that could affect my future legal practice. It was very useful in my TC interview, to be able to speak confidently about these issues and demonstrate my commercial awareness...and allowed me to develop a habit which would be materially beneficial in my TC interview and vac scheme.

I graduate officially in July 2023. I will then start a training contract at a commercial law firm in September 2023. As I have caring responsibilities for my grandfather, I could not leave the region...and have therefore joined a commercial firm in Newcastle. I love the region but I am also very ambitious and motivated. I may find myself in London in the future.

'They' say you can't go from the regions to the City, but I wonder what 'they' think of a homeless person going to university unsupported through his late 20's and early 30's, securing a TC at the only firm he applied to while caring for his grandfather, working three jobs and chairing the North East Junior Lawyers Division. As the ASF proves, such barriers are there to be broken
